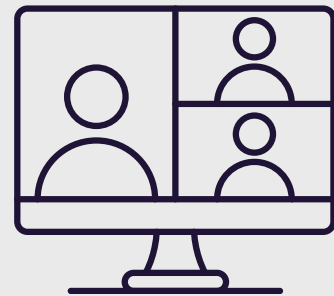

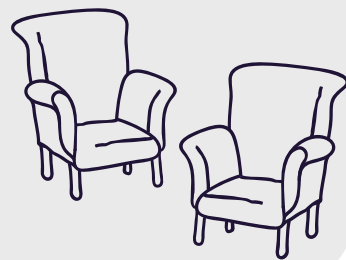


40% of students and alumni strongly agreed or agreed that the panel discussion was engaging and added to their understanding of the future of work within Federal Government organizations.
